TASKS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND TRY OUT PHASE May – October 2016

I. Develop your own project

Preparation phase

Carry out until: **12. June 2016**

1. Develop project idea :
 - Topic & content
 - Pedagogical approach & method
 - Pedagogical goals
 - Target group(s)
 - Evaluation (how to do it?)
 - Make agreements with local partners
 - Timetable & milestones
2. Publish your project idea on the blog (could use existing methods, refer to this methods) & possibly discuss your idea with the other participants

Try out phase

Carry out until: **End of August 2016**

1. Carry out your method (workshop/seminar/project)
2. Document the educational process (pictures, how many participants, date, objectives, schedule)
3. Evaluate the method with your participants

Evaluation phase:

Carry out until: **11. September 2016**

1. Share your experiences on our project blog:
 - Write a short summary of the application of the method (including evaluation)
 - Point out questions and problems which has risen during the project
2. The other participants of the training course in Berlin should discuss about the other projects on the blog and if required make proposals to solve the problems and answer the questions. That means to use the comment function to comment on questions and problems, to reflect on the method/project, to give constructive feedback.
3. The blog also provides you with the opportunity to post material and links to (other people's) methods and other (similar) projects/networks you might know and that can be inspiring for you and others. Fell free to use it to make you network of ideas visible.
4. Participants, who carried out the method should think about, if they want to change/improve their method, tell the result in Amsterdam, discuss open questions and problems/feedbacks in Amsterdam.
5. Possibly publish a detailed version of your improved method on the blog; it should be possible for other trainers to use your schedule to carry out your method by themselves.
