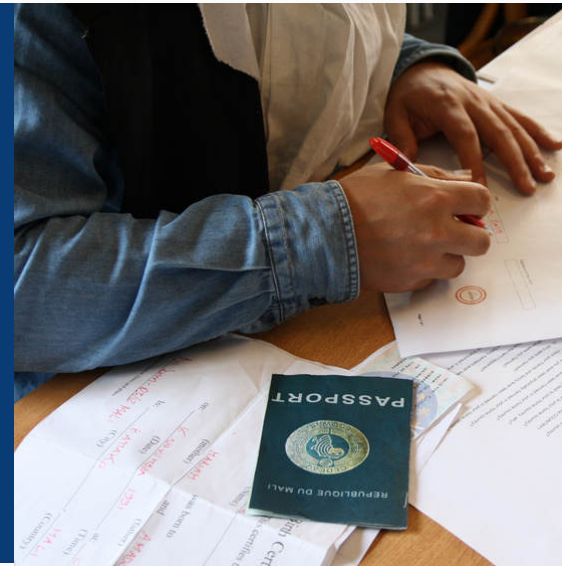

Minosia Labyrinth is an interactive role play and simulation game on migration in Europe. It raises awareness on the complexities of the migration process and the difficulties migrants and refugees face in Europe. By “stepping in the footsteps” of a migrant, refugee – or for example a lawyer, journalist or immigration officer – the reality of migrants and refugees becomes more comprehensible. The game creates empathy and enhances understanding for the people affected by migration. It offers a multidimensional approach to reflect on borders, privileges, power structures and stereotypes.



We invite you to experience Minosia Labyrinth together with an international group of learners with and without lived migration experience. Together we will reflect on and discuss issues related to inclusion, anti-racism and discrimination, our colonial heritage and explore the perspectives of migrants/refugees and critical resistance.

**Please note: This training course is part of a Training-of-Trainers, which means that new facilitators supported by experienced facilitators will be your trainers during the Minosia Labyrinth experience.**

- Residence and/or work in Austria, Denmark, the Netherlands or Germany.

\*The facilities are not designed barrier-free.

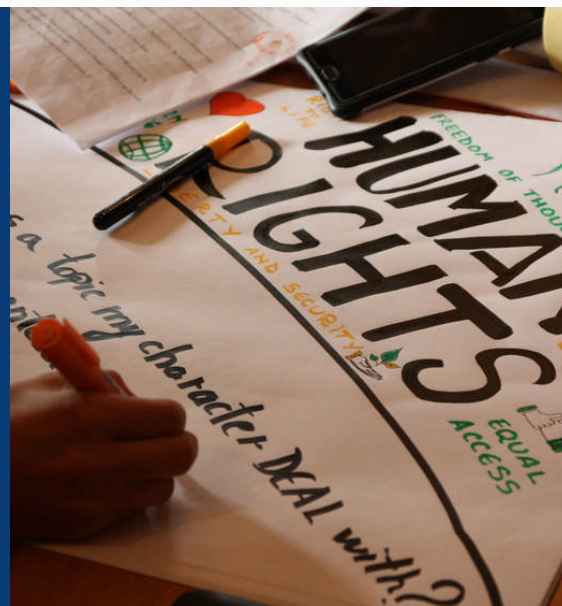
